## AWARDS INFORMATION RIBBONS AND POINTS



Ribbons will be awarded through 6th place except for Crossrails Rider, Beginning Horsemanship and Walk Trot divisions which will be awarded through 8th place. Riders must show in two classes per division to qualify for the show championships. Points are awarded as follows: 1st place-6 points, 2nd place-4 points, 3rd place-3 points, 4th place-2 points, 5th place-1 point. If there are 11 or more entries add 2 points per place. If there are 20 or more in a class, the class will be split. Champion and Reserve Champion are awarded in the following divisions:

**NOTE:** All ribbons and prizes not claimed by the end of the show Sunday will be forfeited.

### YEAR END AWARDS

**Eligibility:** Each rider must be a member of SNHJA as of show date (no retroactive points if you join after showing). *To be eligible for a year-end award, rider must compete for points in the division in at least three shows during the year.* Annual champion and reserve champion awards are presented at the Year-End banquet in the following divisions:

\*In the Walk/Trot, Beginning Horsemanship/Eq., Crossrail Horse, Crossrail Rider, Mini-Eq (formerly Limit Eq) and Baby Green divisions once a rider and/or horse has won the year-end champion or reserve champion award, they will not be eligible to show again in that division.

**Points:** The rider accumulates points in equitation classes. Riders may show on different horses throughout the year. The horse accumulates points in hunter classes.

## RULES, REGULATIONS AND GENERAL INFORMATION

ALL MEMBERS AND EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR KNOWING THE RULES GOVERNING OUR HORSE SHOWS.

A Rule Book Is Available In The Show Office

- CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION:** The Horse Show Management reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. The Horse Show Management shall decide all questions not covered in this premium: its decision to be final. The Horse Show Management reserves to itself the right to disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of the entries and cancel award prizes, without any claim for damages, to change any course, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors to change rings or rotate judges, to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants.

Exhibitors are responsible for knowledge of the rules governing the horse show and for their own errors and omissions. In the case of violation of the cross entry restriction, the entry will forfeit its entry fee, class placing and prize money.

For every horse entered herein for competition, the horse will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the show management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the horse show, and the officials, employees, directors, officers, sponsoring entities of the horse show and the facilities at which the show is held blameless for any loss or accident to himself, his horses, employees or equipments which may occur from sickness, fire or other cause.

- ENTRY PROCESS:** Complete your entry online at [www.horseshowtime.com](http://www.horseshowtime.com) or fill out the enclosed entry form and fax to 702-583-7352. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY SATURDAY 5 PM PRIOR TO THE SHOW DATE. After this date, the \$15.00 Post Entry Fee will be added. NO PHONE ENTRIES. In case of a minor, the parent or guardian must sign entry form and provide an emergency phone number. Payment does not need to be made with pre-entries. Full payment in the form of cash or blank check MUST be left with the show office in order to receive numbers.

*Trainers must leave a trainer's check before any numbers will be released to clients by the office. Trainers' checks will be available for return after the last client has checked out with the office.*

**ATTENTION ADDITIONAL RIDERS OF SHARED HORSE:** *All riders must check in and leave a check in the office even if the horse's number has been released to another rider.*

Exhibitors that compete without being entered and those who enter at the gate will be charged double. Incomplete entry forms, such as those that have no classes listed, are subject to post entry fee. IF PAYING IN CASH, NO ENTRY CHANGES WILL BE ALLOWED. A \$40 fee will be imposed on any returned check. Returned checks will not be processed a second time and payment must be received in the form of money order, cashier's check or cash within 10 days of notice for original amount plus the penalty. Tack stall splits shall be submitted by trainers during the show, not later than Friday afternoon. Show office hours: Thursday, 9-5; Friday, 8-5; Saturday/Sunday, 7-1/2-hour after show ends. Horses on show grounds for schooling only must have an entry form submitted and pay for grounds or stall fees.

4. **FEES:** Regular class...\$17 Stakes Class...\$20 Leadline Class... \$10 (flat fee) Medal Class...\$20 CPHA Medal Class...\$25 SNHJA Non-Member Fee...\$30 Grounds Fee...\$55 (no stall requested) Post Entry Fee...\$15 (per show) Vendor fee...\$40 Stall Fee...\$55 (bedding not included) Jump set-up fee...\$5 (per horse/rider combination) RV hook-ups...\$15 per night **SNHJA Show Fee (Mandatory)...\$15 per horse/rider combination**
5. **MINOR EXHIBITORS:** Parents or guardians of minor exhibitors (juniors) shall hold the SNHJA, Clark County (Horseman's Park) and Show Management harmless for injury to such minor. No child's entry will be accepted without the signature of parent or guardian on the entry form. The signatures of instructors, agents or other unrelated persons will not be accepted.
6. **JUDGES:** It is the purpose of the Management to run the horse show at the highest possible level of sportsmanship. The judges' decisions in the show ring are their own responsibility and management accepts no responsibility for those decisions. No one shall approach a judge without first obtaining an appointment.
7. **AGE DIVISIONS:** The age of an individual on December 1, 2009 (in accordance with USEF rules) will be maintained throughout the entire competitive year (or November 30, 2010, whichever is sooner).
8. **ATTIRE:** Proper hunt attire. Jackets required unless announced otherwise at the judge's discretion. Properly fitting protective headgear must be worn when riding anywhere on the show grounds. As required by the USEF, all riders must wear an approved, harnessed safety helmet that meets or exceeds ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag.
9. **PARKING:** All vehicles and trailers must be parked at least 30 feet from the barns per fire marshal regulations.
10. **SCHOOLING:** An adult must supervise junior riders jumping in the warm-up arena and during schooling rounds. Schooling fences must be jumped in the proper direction. Schooling rounds in the show arena are available: **Wednesday afternoon after jump setup, Thursday before noon & evening, Friday before 9 AM & evening, Saturday before 7:30 AM & evening, and Sunday before 7:30 AM. There is a limit of 10 riders in the arena at any time. Courtesy is the rule in warm-up arena. People on foot or lunging in the warm-up arena, please give way to riders schooling over fences.**
11. **DOGS AND OTHER PETS:** Dogs or other pets in stable area or anywhere on the grounds must be on a **leash and supervised**. People with pets exhibiting **aggressive behavior** may be asked to immediately remove the pet from the show grounds.
12. **CLEANUP:** Horseman's park assesses SNHJA a fee based on the extent of cleanup that is required by their crews. To lower this cost, please clean up after yourself and your horse. Do not leave bulk shavings on the ground. Shavings only, no straw allowed. For horses tied to trailers please put your manure at the end of the barns— **NO MANURE IN THE TRASH CANS.** If you place manure in trash cans you will be charged a fee.
13. **HC:** A rider who wishes to warm-up or ride in a class with cross entry restrictions without losing SNHJA year-end points in their division may enter any such class as "HC" which means they will not be judged and will not receive a ribbon or points. "HC" riders must adhere to the course as posted and should ride first in the order of go. There will be no "HC" riders allowed in any flat class. Also, riders may not ride "HC" in an "A" division when showing in the "B" division of the **SAME** class.

To be judged on performance and soundness with manners emphasized. To be scored under the open numerical judging system. Each competitor will jump one round of approximately 8 fences at 3'0". The top ten(10) horses from the first round will return to jump a second round in reverse order of their scores in the first round, lowest score going first and highest score going last. In case of ties, order of those determine the winners. In case of a tie for first place only, tied horses will jump a third round over a shortened course to break the tie. In all other ties, the prize money will be added and divided equally and riders will toss a coin for the ribbons. The classic will not count toward a show champion award. The classic will be held on Sunday, April 25th, 2010.

#### **Eligibility**

Riders are limited to juniors and amateurs. Riders are not permitted to enter the 2'0" or 2'6" classics.

#### **Membership**

Must be a member of the Southern Nevada Hunter Jumper Association prior to Sunday, April 25th, 2010.

#### **FORMAL ATTIRE REQUIRED**

Ribbons and prize money awarded to 8th place. **If the classic is not sponsored**, prize money will be awarded according to the number of entries.

The top ten(10) horses from the first round will return to jump a second round in reverse order of their scores in the first round, lowest score going first and highest score going last. In case of ties, order of those determine the winners. In case of a tie for first place only, tied horses will jump a third round over a shortened course to break the tie. In all other ties, the prize money will be added and divided equally and riders will toss a coin for the ribbons. The classic will not count toward a show champion award. The classic will be held on Sunday, April 25th, 2010.

#### Eligibility

Riders are limited to juniors and amateurs who have not shown and completed any courses over 2'9".

#### Membership

Must be a member of the Southern Nevada Hunter Jumper Association prior to Sunday, April 25th, 2010.

#### FORMAL ATTIRE REQUIRED

#### AWARDS AND PRIZE MONEY

Ribbons and prize money awarded to 8th place. **If the classic is not sponsored**, prize money will be awarded according to the number of entries.

PLEASE NOTE: This class will have 2 rounds. (see time schedule pg.14) You must be entered in the Classic prior to the start of these rounds.

April Show ONLY

- 14. CLASSES:** Each class must have at least **two** riders entered for the class to be held. If there are less than **three** riders, half points will be awarded and there will be no champion or reserve champion during the show. *Show Secretary has sole authority to make division assignments. See postings outside office the night before competition to confirm "A/B" assignments. "A" and "B" divisions in large classes will be combined the night before competition if no horse conflicts, for ≤10 entries for crossrails and walk/trot; for ≤16 entries for all other classes divided into divisions. In "A" and "B" divisions, "A" riders cannot ride in "B" division and "B" riders cannot ride in "A" division.*
- 15. ABUSE:** Competitors who abuse horses will be eliminated by the judge and or the SNHJA board and may be subject to fines/or additional penalties.

### CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

#### Hunter Division

**HUNTER COURSES:** Courses offered at this show will consist of 7 to 9 fences with one or two direction changes. The fences will simulate obstacles found in the hunt field, such as brush, posts and rails, walls, in-and-outs, gates, etc. Course diagrams will be posted one-half hour before each class.

**UNDER SADDLE CLASSES:** Horses to be shown at walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. Horses should be obedient, alert and responsive and move freely. They should not be eliminated for slight error. No martingales permitted.

**TROT OVER POLES AND WALK/TROT EQUITATION:** Open to the beginner rider who has never shown over fences at any show on any horse. Riders may only cross-enter into flat or U/S classes, but not any jumping classes. Year-end champion and reserve champion riders from prior years may not compete in this division.

**Class 200—Hunter Under Saddle    Class 201—Equitation Flat    Class 202—Over Poles**

#### CROSSRAIL HORSE

Open to the horse of any age that has never shown over fences exceeding 2'3" at any show with any rider. Horse may not cross-enter into any class where fences exceed 2'3". The crossrail jumps measure 18" and will not include gates or flower boxes. Year-end champion and reserve champion horses from prior years may not compete in this division.

**Class 302—Under Saddle    Class 303—Over Fences    Class 304—Over Fences Stakes**

#### CROSSRAIL RIDER

Open to the beginner amateur rider of any age who has never shown over fences exceeding 2' at any show on any horse. The crossrail jumps measure 18" and will not include gates or flower boxes. Trotting not to be penalized. Riders may not cross-enter into any class where fences exceed 2' on any horse. Year-end champion and reserve champion riders from prior years may not compete in this division.

The classic will be held on Saturday, April 24th, 2010.

#### Eligibility

Riders are limited to juniors and amateurs who have not shown and completed any courses over 2'3".

#### Membership

Must be a member of the Southern Nevada Hunter Jumper Association prior to Saturday, April 24th, 2010.

### **Hunter Division continued**

#### **OPEN HUNTER**

Fences are 3'0". No cross-entry restriction.

**Class 112—Under Saddle    Class 113—Over Fences    Class 114—Over Fences Stakes**

#### **AA/CHILDREN'S HUNTER**

Open to amateur riders showing horses and ponies. Fences are 3'0. Spreads not to exceed fence height. In-and-Outs will not be adjusted for ponies.

### **Hunter Seat Equitation**

The SNHJA Hunt Seat Equitation Classes are open to both junior and adult amateur riders as defined by USEF.

#### **BEGINNING HORSEMANSHIP/ EQUITATION**

Open to the beginner rider who has never shown over fences at any show on any horse. Riders may only cross-enter into flat or U/S classes, but not any jumping classes. Year-end champion and reserve champion riders from prior years may not compete in this division. Tests: halt, back up, circles, lengthening of the stride and questions from the judge.

**Class 300—Equitation Flat    Class 301—Horsemanship Flat**

#### **MINI EQUITATION 2'0"**

Open to riders who have never shown over fences exceeding 2'3". Fences are 2'. Year-end champion and reserve champion riders from prior years (formerly "Limit Equitation") may not compete in this division.

#### **EQUITATION 2'9"**

Riders are required to jump no less than eight obstacles at 2'9". Riders in this division may not cross enter into another equitation or hunter division where the fences exceed 3' in height and the rider may not cross enter Jumper classes where the fences exceed 3'3".

### **Medal Classes**

Riders entered in the SNHJA Medal Classes must be members of SNHJA prior to showing in the medal classes. Those competitors who are not members prior to entering the class will not be eligible for points. The top eight in point standings (including all ties) will compete in the finals in October. Points will be awarded as follows...6,4,3,2,1.

#### **SNHJA 2'0" MEDAL**

Riders must be members of the Southern Nevada Hunter Jumper Association. Riders are required to jump no less than eight obstacles at 2'0" over hunter type fences. Top 4 riders to work-off. Riders may not have shown over fences exceeding 2'3" on any horse to be eligible. (Tests 1-8)

#### **SNHJA 2'6" MEDAL**

Riders must be members of the Southern Nevada Hunter Jumper Association. Riders are required to jump no less than eight obstacles at 2'6" over hunter or jumper type fences. Top 4 riders to work-off. Riders may not have shown over fences exceeding 2'9" on any horse to be eligible. (Tests 1-11)

#### **Class 215—SNHJA Medal 2'6"**

#### **SNHJA MEDAL 2'9"**

Riders must be members of the Southern Nevada Hunter Jumper Association. Riders are required to jump no less than eight obstacles at 2'9" over hunter or jumper type fences. Top 4 riders to work-off. Riders in this division may not cross enter into another equitation or hunter division where the fences exceed 3' in height and the rider may not cross enter Jumper classes where the fences exceed 3'3". (Tests 1-11)

#### **Class 121—SNHJA Medal 2'9"**

#### **SNHJA 3'0" MEDAL**

Riders must be members of the Southern Nevada Hunter Jumper Association. Riders are required to jump no less than eight obstacles at 3'0" over hunter or jumper type fences. Top 4 riders to work-off. Water jump may be included. (Tests 1-19)

#### **Class 325—SNHJA Medal 3'0"**

#### **SNHJA 3'3" MEDAL**

Riders must be members of the Southern Nevada Hunter Jumper Association. Riders are required to jump no less than eight obstacles at 3'3" over hunter or jumper type fences. Top 4 riders to work-off. Water jump may be included. Riders may also compete in the SNHJA Medal 3'0". (Tests 1-19)

#### **Class 108—SNHJA Medal 3'3"**

### CPHA Medal Classes

Trainers and competitors must show CPHA membership card at the show office or join at the show prior to showing in the CPHA classes.

#### **CPHA Horsemanship Medal**

This class is open to Child and Adult riders who have never won any PCHA or USEF or National medal class, hunter or jumper class with fences 3' or higher in any rated horse show. Riders may not compete if they have won any association (SNHJA) medal finals where the fences are 3'.

The class will be held over a 2'6" course with a minimum of eight fences, no combinations and at least two changes of direction. One test of either a halt or trot fence must be included in the course. At least two riders must complete the course. Three (3) points qualifies for the finals. Must have two entries to fill the class and two to complete the course. Points awarded: 6-4-3-2-1; 4-3-2-1 for 4 riders; 3-2-1 for 3 riders; 2-1- for 2 riders.

#### **CPHA Child/Adult Medal**

This class is open to child and adult riders who have never won any PCHA, USEF or National medal class, hunter and or jumper class with fences 3'3" at any rated horse show. Riders may not compete if they have won any association medal finals (this includes SNHJA) with fences 3'3" or higher.

The class will be held over a 3' course with a minimum of eight fences with at least two changes of direction and a combination. At least two riders shall work off using USEF tests 1-9. A minimum of two riders must complete the course. Three (3) points qualifies for the finals. Two entries to fill the class and two to complete the course. Points awarded: 6-4-3-2-1; 4-3-2-1 for 4 riders; 3-2-1 for 3 riders; 2-1 for 2 riders.

Open to horse or rider who has never shown over a jumper course with fences exceeding 2'9". The same rider/horse combination may not cross enter into any jumper class at any horseshow with fences exceeding 2'9".
