

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

TRAINING JUMPERS 3'0"

Open to any horse. Table to be posted with the course. Fences 3'0" to 3'3"

Class 108 —Training Jumpers 3'0" Class 109—Training Jumpers 3'0" Stakes

OPEN JUMPERS 3'6"

Open to any horse. Table to be posted with the course. Fences 3'6", spreads 3'6" to 4'

Class 113 —Open Jumpers 3'6" Class 114—Open Jumpers 3'6" Stakes

Medal Classes

SNHJA MEDAL 2'0"*

Riders must be members of the Southern Nevada Hunter Jumper Association. Riders are required to jump no less than eight obstacles at 2'0" over hunter type fences. Top 4 riders to work-off. Riders may not have shown over fences exceeding 2'3" on any horse to be eligible. (Tests 1-8)

Class 307 —SNHJA Medal 2'0" Class 506 —SNHJA Year end Medal 2'0"

SNHJA MEDAL 2'6"*

Riders must be members of the Southern Nevada Hunter Jumper Association. Riders are required to jump no less than eight obstacles at 2'6" over hunter type fences. Top 4 riders to work-off. Riders may not have shown over fences exceeding 2'9" on any horse to be eligible. (Tests 1-11)

Class 218 —SNHJA Medal 2'6" Class 507 —SNHJA Year end Medal 2'6"

SNHJA MEDAL 2'9"*

Riders must be members of the Southern Nevada Hunter Jumper Association. Riders are required to jump no less than eight obstacles at 2'9" over hunter type fences. Top 4 riders to work-off. Riders in this division may not cross enter into another equitation division where the fences exceed 3' in height and the rider may not cross enter hunter or jumper classes where the fences exceed 3'3". (Tests 1-11)

Class 226 —SNHJA Medal 2'9" Class 504—SNHJA Year end Medal 2'9"

SNHJA MEDAL 3'0"*

Riders must be members of the Southern Nevada Hunter Jumper Association. Riders are required to jump no less than eight obstacles at 3'0" over hunter or jumper type fences. Top 4 riders to work-off. Water jump may be included. (Tests 1-19)

Class 323 —SNHJA Medal 3'0" Class 509 —SNHJA Year end Medal 3'0"

SNHJA MEDAL 3'3"*

Riders must be members of the Southern Nevada Hunter Jumper Association. Riders are required to jump no less than eight obstacles at 3'3" over hunter or jumper type fences. Top 4 riders to work-off. Water jump may be included. Riders may also compete in the SNHJA Medal 3'0". (Tests 1-19)

Class 112 —SNHJA Medal 3'3" Class 500 —SNHJA Year end Medal 3'3"

*Riders entered in the SNHJA Medal Classes must be members of SNHJA prior to showing in the medal classes. Those competitors who are not members prior to entering the class will not be eligible for points. The top eight in point standings (including all ties) will compete in the finals in October. Points will be awarded as follows...6,4,3,2,1.

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

Hunter Division

HUNTER COURSES: Courses offered at this show will consist of 7 or 8 fences with one or two direction changes. The fences will simulate obstacles found in the hunt field, such as brush, posts and rails, walls, ins and outs, gates, aikens, ect. Course diagrams will be posted one-half hour before each class.

UNDER SADDLE CLASSES: Horses to be shown at walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. Horses should be obedient, alert and responsive and move freely. They should not be eliminated for slight error. No martingales permitted.

TROT OVER POLES AND WALK/TROT EQUITATION: Open to the beginner rider who has never shown over fences at any show on any horse. Riders may only cross-enter into flat or U/S classes, but not any jumping classes. Year-end champion and reserve champion riders from prior years may not compete in this division.

Class 200 —Under Saddle

CROSSRAILS / HORSE

Open to the horse of any age that has never shown over fences exceeding 2'3" at any show with any rider. Horse may not cross-enter into any class where fences exceed 2'3". Year-end champion and reserve champion horses from prior years may not compete in this division.

Class 300 —Under Saddle

Classes 301 & 302 —Over Fences

CROSSRAILS/BEGINNER RIDER

Open to the beginner rider of any age who has never shown over fences exceeding 2' at any show on any horse. The crossrail jumps measure 18" and may include gates and flower boxes. Trotting not to be penalized. Riders may not cross-enter into any class where fences exceed 2' on any horse. (Amateurs only). Year-end champion and reserve champion riders from prior years may not compete in this division.

Class 204 —Under Saddle

Classes 206 & 207 —Over Fences

Class 205 —Equitation Flat

SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER

Open to the beginner rider 13 and under (as of Dec. 1, 2006) who has never shown over fences exceeding 2'6" on any horse. Fences are 2'3". Rider may not cross-enter into any other class where fences exceed 2'6".

Class 208 —Under Saddle

Classes 209 & 210 —Over Fences

SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION

Open to the beginner rider 13 and under (as of Dec. 1, 2006) who has never shown over fences exceeding 2'6" on any horse. Fences are 2'3". Rider may not cross-enter into any other class where fences exceed 2'6".

Class 211 —Equitation Flat

Class 212 —Over Fences

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

LONG STIRRUP HUNTER

Open to the beginner rider 14 and over as of Dec. 1, 2006 and has never shown over fences exceeding 2'6" on any horse. Fences are 2'3". Rider may not cross-enter into any other class where fences exceed 2'6". (Amateurs Only)

Class 213 —Under Saddle **Classes 214 & 215 —Over Fences**

LONG STIRRUP EQUITATION

Open to the beginner rider 14 and over as of Dec. 1, 2006 and has never shown over fences exceeding 2'6" on any horse. Fences are 2'3". Rider may not cross-enter into any other class where fences exceed 2'6". (Amateurs Only)

Class 216 —Under Saddle **Class 217 —Over Fences**

SCHOOLING PONY HUNTER

Open to ponies 14.2 hands and under. Fences are 2'3" or 2'9". May compete at any fence height regardless of pony size. The pony may only compete once in each class. (Amateurs only).

Class 308 —Under saddle **Classes 309 & 310 —Over Fences**

SCHOOLING PONY EQUITATION

Open to ponies 14.2 hands and under. Fences are 2'3" or 2'9". May compete at any fence height regardless of pony size. The rider may only compete once in each class. (Amateurs only).

Class 311 —Under saddle **Class 312 —Over Fences**

BABY GREEN HUNTER

Open to the beginner horse of any age that has never shown over fences exceeding 2'6" prior to Dec. 1, 2006. However, a horse showing in baby green may then move up to show a maximum of 2'9" during their baby green year and still retain baby green status for current year only. Fences are 2'6". Year-end champion and reserve champion horses from prior years may not compete in this division.

Class 101 —Under saddle **Classes 102 & 103 —Over Fences**

MODIFIED CHILDREN / ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER

Open to junior and adult amateur rider. Manners shall be emphasized and extreme speed shall be penalized. Fences are 2'6".

Class 314 —Under saddle **Classes 315 & 316 —Over Fences**

LOW HUNTER

Fences are 2'9". No cross-entry restriction.

Class 219 —Under saddle **Classes 220 & 221 —Over Fences**

OPEN HUNTER

Fences are 3'0". No cross-entry restriction.

Class 105 —Under saddle **Classes 106 & 107 —Over Fences**

CHILDREN'S HUNTER

Open to horses and ponies ridden by a junior exhibitor 17 and under as of Dec 1, 2006. Fences are 3'0. Spreads not to exceed fence height. In-and-Outs will not be adjusted for ponies.

Class 317 —Under Saddle **Classes 318 & 319 —Over Fences**

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

ADULT AMATEUR

Open to riders who have reached their 18th birthday as of Dec 1, 2006, who are defined as amateur under USEF rules. Fences 3'0"

Class 320 —Under Saddle **Classes 321 & 322 —Over Fences**

SNHJA HUNTER

Open to any horse / rider combination. Fences are 3'3" or 3'6". No cross-entry restriction. May only compete once in each class.

Class 324 —Under Saddle **Classes 325 & 326 —Over Fences**

Hunter Seat Equitation

The SNHJA Hunt Seat Equitation Classes are open to both junior and adult amateur riders as defined by USEF.

MINI EQUITATION 2'0" CLASSES

Open to junior and adult amateur riders who have never shown over fences exceeding 2'3". Fences are 2'. Year-end champion and reserve champion riders from prior years (formerly "Limit Equitation") may not compete in this division.

Class 304 —Equitation Flat **Classes 305 & 306 Over Fences**

EQUITATION 2'9" CLASS

Open to junior and amateur riders on any horse. Riders 17 and under must be 17 on or before Dec. 1, 2006. Riders in this division may not cross enter into any other equitation or medal class where the fences exceed 3' in height.

Class 222—Equitation 17 & Under Flat **Class 223—Equitation 17 & Under Over Fences**

Class 224—Equitation 18 & up Flat **Class 225—Equitation 18 & up Over Fences**

OPEN EQUITATION 3'3"

Open to junior and amateur riders on any horse. Fences are 3'3".

Class 110—Equitation Flat **Class 111—Equitation Over Fences**

Jumper Division

HOPEFUL JUMPERS 2'6"

Open to horse or rider who has never shown over a jumper course with fences exceeding 2'9". The same Rider/Horse combination may not cross enter into any jumper class at any horseshow with fences exceeding 2'9".

Class 115—Hopeful Jumpers 2'6" **Class 116 — Hopeful Jumpers 2'6" Stakes**

Class 115 to be judged according to Argentinean time.

SCHOOLING JUMPERS 2'9"

Open to horse or rider who has never shown over a jumper course with fences exceeding 2'9". The same Rider/Horse combination may not cross enter into any jumper class at any horseshow with fences exceeding 3'3".

Class 117—Schooling Jumpers 2'9" **Class 118—Schooling Jumpers 2'9" Stakes**
