Please be reminded that shavings are not permitted to be delivered to Horseman's Park for horse shows.

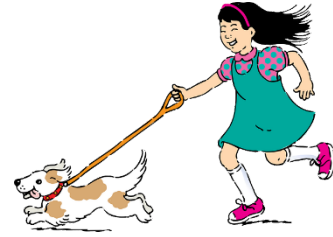

HORSE SHOW REMINDERS...

When you are removing horses from Horseman's Park, please lock the stall doors.

Dogs or other pets on show grounds must be on a leash and supervised at all times. There will be a \$25 fine for each instance of a dog off a leash and a call to Animal Control for non-compliance



Also, only **blue** or **green** painters tape will be allowed for labeling stalls or posting anything in the barn area.



Parking and RV Use:

1. No parking is allowed within 30 feet of Horseman's Park barns. Besides this being a violation of fire code, it prevents park staff from picking up manure. Park police can give a ticket to violators.
2. Do not park in front of RV stations if you are not using them. Parking in RV spaces will subject you to the \$20 day/night or any portion of a day/night RV charge. There is plenty of parking available in the West parking lot.
3. IMMEDIATELY AFTER HOOKING UP YOUR RV TO AN RV STATION, notify the Show Office.
4. Violators will receive a written warning posted on their RV if they have not registered their RV at the Show Office. If you ignore the warning, your RV could be subject to TOWING.
5. Barbeques with flames or any kind of cooking with flames are not permitted on the grass area outside the show office or in the barn area. A designated pit is available behind the bleachers.



AWARDS INFORMATION RIBBONS AND POINTS RIBBONS AND



Ribbons will be awarded through 6th place for those divisions with jumps greater than 2'0" and through 8th place for divisions 2'0" and less. Riders must show in two classes per division to qualify for the show championships. Points are awarded as follows: 1st place-6 points, 2nd place-4 points, 3rd place-3 points, 4th place-2 points, 5th place-1 point. If there are 11 or more entries add 2 points per place. If there are 20 or more in a class, the class will be split. Champion and Reserve Champion are awarded in the following divisions:

In the Walk/Trot, Walk Trot Barely Canter, Beginning Canter, Crossrail Rider, Mini divisions, once a rider and/or horse has won the year-end champion or reserve champion award, they will not be eligible to show again in that division.

Points: The rider accumulates points in equitation classes. Riders may show on different horses throughout the year. The rider accumulates points in Walk/Trot, W/T Barely Canter, Beginning Canter Divisions and Crossrail rider divisions. The horse accumulates points in hunter classes.

RULES REGULATIONS AND GENERAL INFORMATION

A Rule Book Is Available In The Show Office

1. **CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION:** The Horse Show Management reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. The Horse Show Management shall decide all questions not covered in this premium: its decision to be final. The Horse Show Management reserves to itself the right to disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of the entries and cancel award prizes, without any claim for damages, to change any course, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors to change rings or rotate judges, to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants. Exhibitors are responsible for knowledge of the rules governing the horse show and for their own errors and omissions. In the case of violation of the cross entry restriction, the entry will forfeit its entry fee, class placing and prize money.

For every horse entered herein for competition, the horse will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the show management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the horse show, and the officials, employees, directors, officers, sponsoring entities of the horse show and the facilities at which the show is held blameless for any loss or accident to himself, his horses, employees or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or other cause

2. **ENTRY PROCESS:** Complete your entry online at www.horseshowtime.com or fill out the enclosed entry form and fax to Aubin Skankey at 702-583-7352. **ALL ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY MIDNIGHT FRIDAY BEFORE THE FIRST DAY OF THE SHOW.** After this date, the \$25.00 Post Entry Fee will be added. In case of a minor, the parent or guardian must sign entry form and provide an emergency phone number. Payment does not need to be made with pre-entries. Full payment in the form of cash, credit card or blank check MUST be left with the show office in order to receive numbers.

Trainers must leave a trainer's check before any numbers will be released to clients by the office. Trainers' checks will be available for return after the last client has checked out with the office.

ATTENTION ADDITIONAL RIDERS OF SHARED HORSE: All riders must check in and leave a check in the office even if the horse's number has been released to another rider. Release Forms must be signed before any Exhibitor rides a horse on the show grounds.

Exhibitors may not compete without being entered. A \$40 fee will be imposed on any returned check. Returned checks will not be processed a second time and payment must be received in the form of money order, cashier's check, credit card, or cash within 10 days of notice for original amount plus the penalty. **Tack stall splits shall be submitted by trainers during the show, not later than Friday afternoon.** Show office hours: Friday/Saturday/Sunday, 7am-5:30 pm or until after show ends. Horses on show grounds for schooling only must have an entry form submitted and pay non-showing horse fees as well as for either grounds or stall fees.

RULES, REGULATIONS AND GENERAL INFORMATION, CONT

4. **MINOR EXHIBITORS:** Parents or guardians of minor exhibitors (juniors) shall hold the SNHJA, Clark County (Horseman's Park) and Show Management harmless for injury to such minor. No child's entry will be accepted without the signature of parent or guardian on the entry form. The signatures of instructors, agents or other unrelated persons will not be accepted.
5. **JUDGES:** It is the purpose of the Management to run the horse show at the highest possible level of sportsmanship. The judges' decisions in the show ring are their own responsibility and management accepts no responsibility for those decisions. No one shall approach a judge without first obtaining an appointment.
6. **AGE DIVISIONS:** The age of an individual on December 1, 2016 (in accordance with USEF rules) will be maintained throughout the entire competitive year (or November 30, 2017, whichever is sooner).
7. **ATTIRE:** Proper hunt attire. Jackets required unless allowed otherwise at the judge's discretion. Properly fitting protective headgear must be worn when riding anywhere on the show grounds. As required by the USEF all riders must wear an approved harness safety helmet that meets or exceeds ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag.
8. **PARKING:** All vehicles and trailers must be parked at least 30 feet from the barns per fire marshal regulations.
9. **SCHOOLING:** An adult must supervise junior riders jumping in the warm-up arena and during schooling rounds. Schooling fences must be jumped in the proper direction. Schooling in the show arena are available: **The show arena will be available all day Thursday and until 7:00AM on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Friday and Saturday schooling is permitted until 11:00PM at which time the arena lights are programmed to shut off. There is a limit of 10 riders in the arena at any time. Courtesy is the rule in warm-up arena. People on foot or lunging in the warm-up arena, please give way to riders schooling over fences.**
10. **DOGS AND OTHER PETS: Dogs or other pets in stable area or anywhere on the grounds must be on a leash and supervised. A \$25 fine will be charged for loose dogs and Animal Control will be contacted if the dog is not claimed and the fine paid. People with pets exhibiting aggressive behavior may be asked to immediately remove the pet from the show grounds.**
11. **CLEANUP:** Horseman's park assesses SNHJA a fee based on the extent of cleanup that is required by their crews. To lower this cost, please clean up after yourself and your horse. Do not leave bulk shavings on the ground. Shavings only, no straw allowed. For horses tied to trailers please put your manure at the end of the barns— **NO MANURE IN THE TRASH CANS.** If you place manure in trash can you will be charged a fee.
12. **CLASSES:** Each class must have at least **two** riders entered for the class to be held. If there are less than three riders, half points will be awarded and there will be no champion or reserve champion during the show. Show Secretary has sole authority to make division assignments. See postings outside office the night before competition to confirm "A/B" assignments. "A" and "B" divisions in large classes will be combined the night before competition if no horse conflicts, for <10 entries for crossrails and walk/trot; for <16 entries for all other classes divided into divisions. In "A" and "B" divisions, "A" riders cannot ride in "B" division and "B" riders cannot ride in "A" division.
13. **ABUSE:** Competitors who abuse horses may be eliminated by the judge and/or the SNHJA board and may be subject to fines and/or additional penalties.

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

Hunter Division

HUNTER COURSES: Courses offered at this show will consist of 7 to 9 fences with one or two direction changes. The fences will simulate obstacles found in the hunt field, such as brush, posts and rails, walls, in-and-outs, gates, etc. Course diagrams will be posted one-half hour before each class.

UNDER SADDLE CLASSES: Horses to be shown at walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. Horses should be obedient, alert and responsive and move freely. They should not be eliminated for slight error. No martingales permitted.

WALK TROT HUNTER

Open to the beginner rider who has never shown over fences at any show on any horse. Riders may only cross-enter into Walk Trot Barely Canter classes number 200 and 201. Year-end champion and reserve champion riders from prior years may not compete in this division.

Class 162—Under Saddle Class 163—Walk Trot Pleasure Class 164—Trot Over Poles

WALK TROT BARELY CANTER

Open to the beginner rider who has not shown over fences at any show except the Beginning Canter Division with two crossrails. Riders will be asked to canter individually. Riders may cross enter into Walk/Trot classes or Beginning Canter Classes, but not both. Year-end champion and reserve champion riders from prior years may not compete in this division.

Class 200—Walk Trot Barely Canter Eq. on the Flat Class 201—Walk Trot Barely Canter Under Saddle

CROSSRAIL RIDER HUNTER

Open to the beginner Jr. or amateur rider of any age who has never shown over fences exceeding 2' at any show on any horse. The crossrail jumps measure 18" and will not include gates or flower boxes. Jump cups are set at 2'3". Trotting not to be penalized. Riders may not cross-enter into any class where fences exceed 2' on any horse. Year-end champion and reserve champion riders from prior years may not compete in this division.

Class 176—Under Saddle Class 177—Over Fences Class 178—Over Fences 2nd Rd

BEGINNING CANTER HUNTER

Open to the beginner rider who has not shown over fences at any show except the crossrail divisions. Riders will be asked to canter individually. All classes will be judged as hunter classes. For class 168 of this division riders will be asked to jump over 2 crossrails in a line and may trot or canter the line. Riders may not cross enter into any Walk Trot classes. Riders can only cross enter into Walk Trot Barely Canter or Crossrail divisions. Year-end champion and reserve champion riders from prior years may not compete in this division.

Class 173— Beginning Canter Under Saddle Class 174—Beginning Canter Pleasure Class 175—Beginning Canter Hunter Hack (2 Crossrails)

MINI HUNTER 2'

Open to riders who have not shown over fences exceeding 2'3". Fences are 2'. Trotting for lead changes is permitted. Year-end champion and reserve champion riders from prior years may not compete in this division.

Class 179— Mini Hunter Under Saddle Class 180—Mini Hunter Over Fences 2' Class 181—Mini Hunter Over Fences 2nd Round

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

Hunter Division, cont.

SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER

Open to the beginner rider **11 and under** (as of Dec. 1, 2016) who has never shown over fences exceeding 2'6" on any horse. Fences may be set up to 2'3"; all oxers are narrow. Rider may not cross-enter into any other class where fences exceed 2'6".

Class 186—Under Saddle Class 187—Over Fences Class 188—Over Fences 2nd Rd

LONG STIRRUP HUNTER

Open to the beginner rider **12 and over** (as of Dec. 1, 2016) who has never shown over fences exceeding 2'6" on any horse. Fences may be set up to 2'3"; all oxers are narrow. Rider may not cross-enter into any other class where fences exceed 2'6".

Class 189—Under Saddle Classes 190—Over Fences Classes 191—Over Fences 2nd Rd

****If either the Short or Long Stirrup classes have fewer than 3 entries, the classes will be combined and pinned together.***

CHILDREN'S PONY HUNTER

Open to amateur riders showing ponies 14.2 hands and under. Fences are 2'0" or 2'3"; oxers are narrow. Riders to declare height they desire to jump at the gate.

Class 183—Under Saddle Class 184—Over Fences Class 185—Over Fences 2nd Rd

LOW CH/AA HUNTER 2'6"

Open to any junior or adult amateur rider who has never shown over fences exceeding 2'9. Fences are 2'6". Manners shall be emphasized and extreme speed shall be penalized. Riders may not cross enter into any other classes where fences exceed 2'9."

Class 152—Under Saddle Class 153—Over Fences Class 154—Over Fences 2nd Rd

SCHOOLING HUNTER 2'0"

Open division. Fences are 2'0". Oxers and flower boxes are not permitted.

Class 100—Under Saddle Class 101—Over Fences Class 102—Over Fences 2nd Rd

SCHOOLING HUNTER 2'3"

Open division. Fences are 2'3".

Class 103—Under Saddle Class 104—Over Fences Class 105—Over Fences 2nd Rd

SCHOOLING HUNTER 2'6"

Open division. Fences are 2'6".

Class 106—Under Saddle Class 107—Over Fences Class108—Over Fences 2nd Rd

MODIFIED HUNTER 2'6"

Open to all riders. Manners shall be emphasized and extreme speed shall be penalized. Fences are 2'6".

Class 169—Under Saddle Class 170—Over Fences Class 171—Over Fences 2nd Rd

LOW HUNTER 2'9"

Fences are 2'9". No cross-entry restriction.

Class 155—Under Saddle Class 156—Over Fences Class 157—Over Fences 2nd Rd

OPEN HUNTER 3'0"

Fences are 3'0". No cross-entry restriction.

Class 109—Under Saddle Class 110—Over Fences Class 111—Over Fences 2nd Rd

AA/CHILDREN'S HUNTER 2'9"

Open to Junior and adult Amateur riders showing horses and ponies. Fences are 2'9". Spreads not to exceed fence height. In-and-Outs will not be adjusted for ponies.

Class 165—Under Saddle Class 166—Over Fences Class 167—Over Fences 2nd Rd

Warm up Classes

WARM UP CLASSES W1, W2, W3

To be held open all day, each day, at every height. No cross entry restrictions. For the convenience of our exhibitors, you may enter this class at any time and enter as often as you wish. You must only do the warm up course that is posted. No ribbons will be awarded. Entry fee is \$20.00.

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

Hunter Seat Equitation

The SNHJA Hunt Seat Equitation Classes are open to both junior and adult amateur riders as defined by USEF.

WALK/TROT EQUITATION

Open to the beginner rider who has never shown over fences at any show on any horse. The Judge will not ask for circles in the flat classes of this division. Riders may cross enter only into Walk Trot Barely Canter classes, 200 and 201. Year-end champion and reserve champion riders from prior years may not compete in this division.

Class 134—Walk/Trot Equitation Flat Class 135—Walk /Trot Obedience Class 136—Walk/Trot Over Poles Equitation

WALK TROT BARELY CANTER: Open to the beginner rider who has not shown over fences at any show except the Beginning Canter Division with two crossrails. Riders will be asked to canter individually. Riders may cross enter into any Walk/Trot classes or Beginning Canter Classes, but not both. Year-end champion and reserve champion riders from prior years may not compete in this division.

Class 200— Walk Trot Barely Canter Eq. on the Flat Class 201—Walk Trot Barely Canter Under Saddle

BEGINNING CANTER EQUITATION

Open to the beginner rider who has not shown over fences at any show except the crossrail divisions. Riders will be asked to canter individually, and may be asked to halt, back up, circle, and possible horsemanship questions. For class 139 of this division riders will be asked to jump over 2 crossrails in a line and may trot or canter the line. Riders may not cross enter into any Walk Trot classes. Year-end Champion and reserve champion riders from prior years may not compete in this division.

Class 137—Beginning Canter Equitation Flat Class Class 138—Beginning Canter Horsemanship Flat Class Class 139—Beginning Canter Horsemanship (2 Crossrails)

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

Hunter Seat Equitation (cont)

CROSSRAIL RIDER EQUITATION

Open to the beginner Jr. or amateur rider of any age who has never shown over fences exceeding 2' at any show on any horse. The crossrail jumps measure 18" and will not include gates or flower boxes. Jump cups are set at 2'3". Trotting not to be penalized. Riders may not cross-enter into any class where fences exceed 2' on any horse. Year-end champion and reserve champion riders from prior years may not compete in this division.

Class 140—Flat Class 141—Over Fences Class 142—Over Fences 2nd Rd

MINI EQUITATION 2'0"

Open to riders who have never shown over fences exceeding 2'3". Fences are 2'. Trotting for lead changes is permitted. Year-end champion and reserve champion riders from prior years may not compete in this division.

Class 143—Mini Equitation Flat Class 144—Mini Equitation Over Fences Class 145—Mini Equitation Over Fences 2nd Rd

****If either the Short or Long Stirrup classes have fewer than 3 entries, the classes will be combined and pinned together.***

SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION

Open to the beginner rider **11 and under** (as of Dec. 1, 2016) who has never shown over fences exceeding 2'6" on any horse. Fences may be set up to 2'3"; all oxers are narrow. Rider may not cross-enter into any other class where fences exceed 2'6".

Class 146—Short Stirrup Equitation Flat Class 147—Short Stirrup Equitation Over Fences

LONG STIRRUP EQUITATION

Open to the beginner rider **12 and over** (as of Dec. 1, 2016) and has never shown over fences exceeding 2'6" on any horse. Fences may be set up to 2'3"; all oxers are narrow. Rider may not cross-enter into any other class where fences exceed 2'6".

Class 148—Long Stirrup Equitation Flat Class 149—Long Stirrup Equitation Over Fences

LOW CH/AA EQUITATION 2'6"

Open to any junior or adult amateur rider who has never shown over fences exceeding 2'9. Fences are 2'6". Manners shall be emphasized and extreme speed shall be penalized. Riders may not cross enter into any other classes where fences exceed 2'9."

Equitation Classes

Class 150—Flat Class 151—Over Fences

EQUITATION 2'9"

Riders are required to jump no less than eight obstacles at 2'9". Riders in this division may not cross enter into another equitation or hunter division where the fences exceed 3' in height and the rider may not cross enter Jumper classes where the fences exceed 3'3".

Class 158—Equitation 2'9" Flat Class 159—Equitation 2'9" Over Fences

EQUITATION 3'0"

Fences are 3'0."

Class 119—Equitation 3'0" Flat Class 120—Equitation 3'0" Over Fences

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

Medal Classes

Riders entered in the SNHJA Medal Classes must be members of SNHJA prior to showing in the medal classes. Those competitors who are not members prior to entering the class will not be eligible for points. The top eight in point standings (including all ties) will compete in the finals in May. Points will be awarded as follows: 6,4,3,2,1.

SNHJA 2'0" MEDAL

Riders must be members of the Southern Nevada Hunter Jumper Association. Riders are required to jump no less than eight obstacles at 2'0" over hunter type fences. Top 4 riders to work-off. Riders may not have shown over fences exceeding 2'3" on any horse to be eligible. (Tests 1-8)

Class 182—SNHJA 2'0" Medal Class 500—SNHJA 2'0" Medal Final

SNHJA 2'6" MEDAL

Riders must be members of the Southern Nevada Hunter Jumper Association. Riders are required to jump no less than eight obstacles at 2'6" over hunter or jumper type fences. Top 4 riders to work-off. Riders may not have shown over fences exceeding 2'9" on any horse to be eligible. (Tests 1-11)

Class 172—SNHJA 2'6" Medal Class 501—SNHJA 2'6" Medal Final

SNHJA 2'9" MEDAL

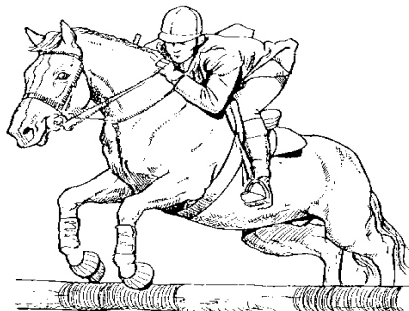

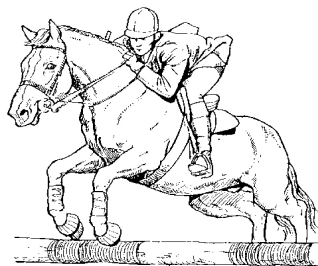

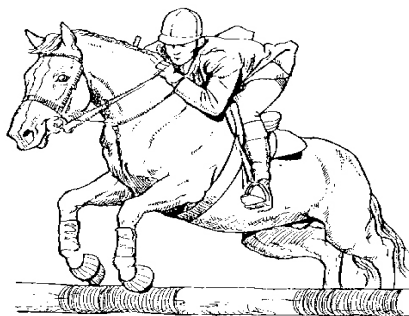
